- Estimated total cost of the Project: The estimated reasonable cost of the total Project is one million dollars and no cents (\$1,000,000).
- Type of assistance: full principal forgiveness.
- Estimated amount of ARRA funds to be used: Four hundred thirty thousand, two hundred sixty-nine dollars and no cents (\$430,269).
