- Project description: The project commonly known as Los Angeles River Trash Nets, generally consists of constructing a trash net system in order to capture trash and debris before they are pumped into the Los Angeles River.
- Estimated total cost of the Project: five hundred sixty-six thousand dollars and no cents (\$566,000).
- Type of assistance: full principal forgiveness.
- Estimated amount of ARRA funds to be used: four hundred three thousand, two hundred dollars (\$403,200).
