- Estimated total cost of the Project: one million, three hundred eighty-eight thousand, five hundred forty-six dollars and no cents (\$1,388,546).
- Type of assistance: full principal forgiveness.
- Estimated amount of ARRA funds to be used: five hundred sixty thousand, two hundred forty-five dollars and no cents (\$560,245).
