


**AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009

The authorized representative of the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) hereby certifies, and/or affirms that the Tomales Bay Wetlands Restoration and Monitoring Program, (Project) has received the full review and vetting required by law and that such representative accepts responsibility that the Project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars. The following general description is provided in order to comply with Section 1511 of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA):

- Project description: The Project, commonly known as the Tomales Bay Wetlands Restoration and Monitoring Program, generally consists of integrating the restoration of the Giacomini Wetland and water quality monitoring to reduce and eliminate existing threats and identify emerging threats that face this critically important watershed, as more particularly described in the financial assistance application of the recipient, Tomales Bay Watershed Council Foundation, and the accepted plans and specifications for the Project.
- Estimated total cost of the Project: Estimated Reasonable Cost. The estimated reasonable cost of the total Project, including associated planning and design costs is two million three thousand dollars and no cents (\$2,003,000).
- Type of assistance: full principal forgiveness.
- Estimated amount of ARRA funds to be used: seven hundred ninety-nine thousand six hundred twenty-nine dollars and no cents (\$799,629).
