


**AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009

The authorized representative of the State Water Resources Control Board hereby certifies, and/or affirms that the Fish Friendly Farming Program Agricultural Clean Water Implementation Project (Project) has received the full review and vetting required by law and that such representative accepts responsibility that the Project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars. The following general description is provided in order to comply with Section 1511 of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA):

- Project description: The Project, commonly known as the Fish Friendly Farming Program Agricultural Clean Water Implementation Project, generally consists of implementing Best Management Practices (BMPs), and demonstrating and expanding BMP implementation through workshops and enrolling farmers into the certification program, in order to reduce sediment and improve water quality and fish habitat.
- Estimated total cost of the Project: One million, fifteen thousand dollars and no cents (\$1,015,000).
- Type of assistance: full principal forgiveness.
- Estimated amount of ARRA funds to be used: Three hundred sixty-two thousand, five hundred forty-two dollars and no cents (\$362,542).
