




The authorized representative of the State Water Board hereby certifies, and/or affirms that the Colorado Lagoon Beaches (Project) has received the full review and vetting required by law and that such representative accepts responsibility that the Project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars. Subject to the provisions of the Financing Agreement, the following general description is provided in order to comply with Section 1511 of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA):

- Project description: The Project, commonly known as Colorado Lagoon Beaches, generally consists of installing low flow diversion structures and trash separation devices on the large storm drains, building a vegetated bioswale along the western arm of the lagoon as outlined in the construction document, and cleaning and modifying the existing culvert to improve tidal flushing, as more particularly described in the financial assistance application of the Agency and the accepted plans and specifications for the Project.
- Estimated total cost of the Project: Estimated Reasonable Cost. The estimated reasonable cost of the total Project, including associated planning and design costs is three million eight hundred eighty eight three thousand eight hundred sixty eight dollars and no cents (\$3,883,868).
- Type of assistance: Full principal forgiveness
- Estimated amount of ARRA funds to be used: Three million two hundred and two thousand nine hundred seventy seven dollars and no cents (\$3,202,977).
